Site Location & Description:

Haven Court is a residential development of 12 detached houses located in Ballyragget, Co. Kilkenny. The site is served by mains water and sewerage, and is accessed via a single entrance from the private roadway serving Brookhaven Nursing Home.

Planning History:

P.04/1521 - Permission granted to construct 12 no. detached dwelling houses together with all ancillary services. Permission is also being sought to reroute and pipe existing surface water drain, all at Donoughmore, Co. Kilkenny.

P.06/1138 – Permission granted to provide rear sunroom extensions and bay windows to 12 no. houses and minor modifications to estate layout of previously approved residential scheme (ref. no. 04/1521).

TIC Request:

The formal application to have Haven Court taken in charge was made by the residents in July 2015. Subsequent to this, the planning authority engaged with the developer to progress the process and complete the remedial works identified by the various service areas. However, unsatisfactory progress led to the planning authority claiming the bond. The full value of the bond has been paid by the bondholder, which will allow all remaining works to be procured and arranged by the planning authority.

Please also note, final taking in charge is not dependent on the completion of the remaining works. If needs be, the completion of the works can continue after taking in charge. This principle applies to works where the planning authority is in receipt of the bond money and is arranging the works.

Recommendation:

Having regard to the planning authority being in receipt of the bond money, and the planned completion of all works identified by the various internal service areas to bring the estate to taking in charge standard; I recommend that Kilkenny County Council initiate proceedings for the taking in charge of Haven Court, Ballyragget, Co. Kilkenny, as outlined on the attached map.
