Notice is hereby given, that at a meeting of the Council to be held after the expiration of 10 days from the date of this notice, it is the intention of Kilkenny County Council, in accordance with Section 183 of the Local Government Act, 2001, to dispose of its interest in land at Barrack Hill, Castlecomer, Co. Kilkenny – as identified on the attached map - by way of long-term lease for a period of 25 years at an annual rent of €750 (seven hundred and fifty euro) with each party to be responsible for their own legal costs associated with the lease. The Consent of the Minister for Housing, Local Government and Heritage is not required.

Background
